

Competition Events – Definitions

CSC is a member club within the Metro North District of Swimming Victoria. Events conducted by Metro North & Swimming Victoria where CSC competes each year are:

Event Type	Eligibility	Eligible Membership Categories
7-10 Encouragement meet	Similar to All Junior except that all swimmers must be registered with Swim Vic as competitive swimmers (ie no unregistered swimmers). Top ten selected to go on to compete against other districts. Ages 7 to 10 yrs only. Also MN top ten will have a competition against District East top ten in lead up to Swim Vic finals.	Competitor Novice
All Junior Eliminations	Designed for swimmers up to the age of 14 yrs who have not had the opportunity to receive medals at State. As such, winners of any medals in State Age, Open and Sprint champs are ineligible to enter competitions. Unregistered swimmers are also encouraged to enter this competition. Top 10 swimmers in each stroke and age group are chosen as semi-finalists to go on and compete against top ten from all other Metro Districts and the chance for the top ten semi-finalists to progress to the finals.	Competitor Novice
Metro North 11/Senior & 10/Under Encouragements	Designed for up and coming swimmers who have not had the opportunity to receive medals at State or District levels. As such, winners of any medals in State Age, Open and Sprint champs and District Champs are ineligible to enter these competitions. Metro North also seeks permission from Swim Vic to allow unregistered swimmers to compete at these two meets.	Competitor Novice
Metro North Aggregate series	Team relay events allowing clubs in Metro North to compete against each other and gain competition experience. All swimmers must be registered with Swim Vic at competitive level. Points gained towards team trophy for 1st and 2nd in each grade awarded at end of year.	Competitor Novice
Metro North Annual Scratch Meet	All 50 mtr events for all age groups. All swimmers must be registered with Swim Vic at competitive level. Meet results submitted to Swim Vic as Qualifying Meet. Open to any Swim Vic registered competitive swimmer (ie not just Metro North clubs).	Competitor
Metro North District Champs	Various events and distances for age groups and open to establish champion swimmers. All swimmers must be registered with Swim Vic at competitive level. Meet results submitted to Swim Vic as Qualifying Meet. Open to Metro North swimmers only. Swimmers will earn points towards age/open champs if they have competed in at least one Aggregate meet.	Competitor
Metro North Short Course T/Trials	To allow competitive swimmers at near State level to achieve official qualifying times at a short course competition. Qualifying times apply to all entries for this meet. All swimmers must be registered with Swim Vic at competitive level. Meet results submitted to Swim Vic as Qualifying Meet.	Competitor
Winter and Spring Interclub	Two separate team based, interclub competitions conducted over 5 weeks each in Winter and the Spring of each year. Conducted at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre.	Competitor
